Project overview	During this project preschool children begin to explore the outdoor environment to find out about the plants and animals that live there. They begin to talk about some of the things they observe, for example, that fallen leaves are crispy and crunchy. They take place in hands-on experiences as they explore the outside environment and make collections of natural resources. Children explore natural resources to create transitional artwork. They begin to sing songs on the theme of autumn.	During this project, preschool children are introduced to photographs and stories that depict various celebrations. They take part in practical activities that support them to talk about special events in their lives and are encouraged to act out familiar scenarios such as meal times and parties. They continue to create transitional art using shiny resources and explore using different media to create artwork.	During this project, preschool children take part in practical activities that support them in developing their understanding of the changing seasons. They explore the outdoor environment and are encouraged to talk about the plants, animals and natural objects they observe. They explore ice and are encouraged to talk about how it feels and what happens when they hold it in their hands. They look at images and share stories on the theme of animals in cold climates and create small worlds based on their experiences during the project. The children listen to winter-themed music and explore colour mixing.	During this project preschool children take part in practical activities that continue to develop their understanding of the changes that happen in the natural world as the seasons change. They go on welly walks on a rainy day, jump in puddles and explore the plants, animals and natural objects outdoors. They make collections of natural resources and begin to talk about the different types of weather they experience. They sing songs and rhymes related to the weather and continue to explore and talk about what happens when	During this project, preschool children take part in practical activities that introduce them to natural phenomena including shadows and reflections. They are encouraged to notice and make shadows outside on sunny days. They explore mirrors and shiny objects to look at their reflections.	During this project, preschool children continue to develop their understanding of the natural world as they experience practical water- based activities. They further develop their understanding of meting and freezing introduced in Winter Wonderland. They are introduced to vocabulary related to capacity, such as full and empty and they begin to explore floating and sinking.
