Newsletter: As of next week, our weekly Newsletter will go out every Thursday instead of a Wednesday.

Parent Governor: Are you interested in being a Parent Governor at our school? If so, we are currently looking to fill a number of roles. Being a Governor is a rewarding and effective way of making a voluntary contribution to your community and to the lives of young people. Governors are appointed by the Governing Board and are the strategic leaders in schools. Please see the school office for further details.

Appointments: Although it may be difficult, we ask if Doctor and Dentist appointments can be made outside school hours. This prevents disruption to your child's work and their class. We also require to see proof of appointments as this is checked by the Education Welfare Officer. Thank you.

Santa's Grotto: As part of the Christmas Fayre festivities on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> December, we are having a visit from Santa between 2.00pm and 4.30pm. The cost will be £4.00 which will include a gift and a photo with Santa. To ensure we have sufficient and suitable presents for all the children wishing to visit Santa, please pay via ParentPay on your chosen time slot service. **There are only 100 tickets available therefore tickets will be sold on a first come first served basis.** This year you do not require a paper ticket as we will have a list of names at the Grotto when you arrive with your child. The closing date to book is Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018. No tickets will be issued after this date.

Parents are invited to join their child at a cost of £3 per adult. **Please note only 2 adults can attend per child and the closing date to make your payment is Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November.** If you wish to attend, please pay via ParentPay on the Adult Christmas Meal Service. If you require a vegetarian meal, please inform the school office so it can be booked. Your child will receive a sandwich option on the days that they do not have a Christmas dinner.

Pre-school & Nursery Christmas Meal: For the Christmas Meal on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> December children must be accompanied by an adult unless they are booked in for a full day. If your child attends an AM session, please collect at 11.45am then go through the school office for your meal. If your child attends a PM session, please arrive at 12pm for your Christmas Meal. Once you have finished your meal with your child, a member of staff will be on hand to take them to their afternoon setting.
