Year 5 visit to **Stoke Museum** on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019

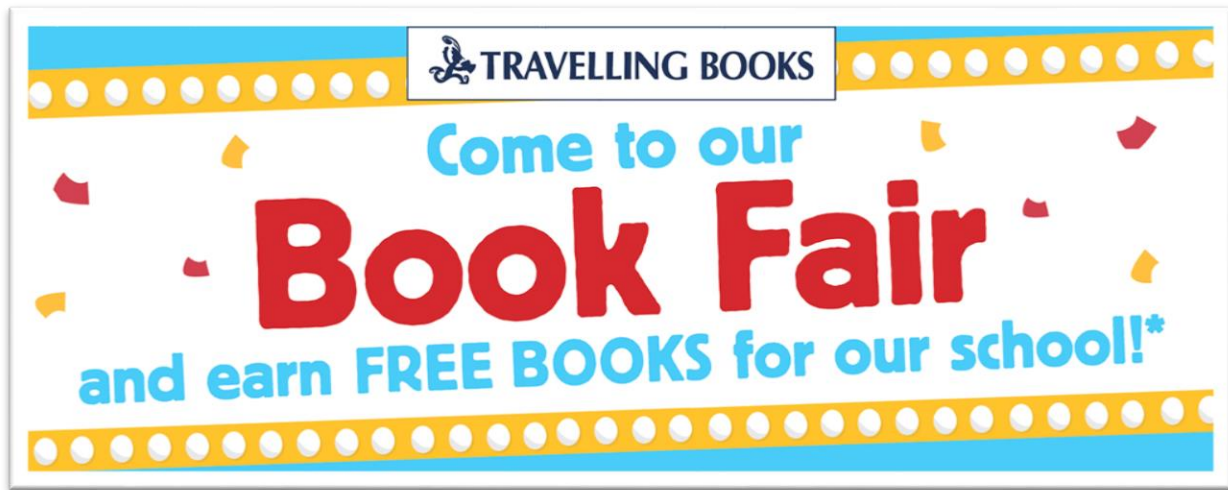
Year 2 visit to **York Railway Museum** on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019
