Pre-school to Year 4 Morning Engagement - Parents are invited into school to spend the morning with their child. On arrival to school, please enter to class with your child where you will register and Sports Day races will then commence at 9.15am. After the races, you will return to class with your child. A limit of one adult per child can stay for lunch and those who do not book a meal with their child will leave at 11.30am.

Year 5 and Year 6 Afternoon Engagement - Parents are invited into school to spend the afternoon with their child. If you are booking a meal with your child, please arrive at 11.20am (limit of 1 adult). Those who are not having lunch and only attending for the afternoon session, please arrive at 1.15pm ready for Sports Day races to commence at 1.30pm. After the races, you will return to class with your child.

Please note if any extra adults are only coming to watch the races please ask them to report to the school office to register where they will then be shown to the school field.

If you wish to have a school meal with your child (limit of 1 adult per child) on their Engagement day please book and pay £4 via ParentPay on the service: "Adult Sports Day Meal" by Tuesday 17th May. Please state if you require a vegetarian meal in the comments box on ParentPay. No bookings or payments can be made after this date and please note, payments must not be made on your child's dinner money service and only adults who have booked a meal can attend for lunch.
